Dear Mr. Welch:

The following information is being provided to confirm the points of discussion from Monday, April 19th:

1. The reimbursement will be based on ADP [REDACTED]
2. The per-inmate-per-month (PIPM) management fee [REDACTED]
performance bond
3. The ADP will be based on a steady [REDACTED] each month and will only change if there is a [RE] increase or decrease above or below the agreed upon [RE] inmates.
4. In addition to the PIPM management fee, Correct Rx will invoice the DDOC for one pharmacist at [RE] per year.
5. A [RE] % discount will be applied to the drugs only for 15 day prompt pay.
6. Correct Rx can provide an interface with the pharmacy module of an EMR system. The cost of the interface with the pharmacy module of the EMR is not to exceed \$ [RE]. Any amount over the \$ [RE] would be negotiated and mutually agreed upon by the DDOC and Correct Rx.
