


- I. AUTHORITY: Bureau of Correctional Healthcare Services
- II. PURPOSE: To ensure the Department of Correction (DOC) has a written policy regarding the detection, prevention, reduction, and punishment of rape consistent with the federal law.
- III. APPLICABILITY: All DOC employees and vendor staff, offenders, and any outside healthcare provider servicing DOC offenders.
- IV. DEFINITIONS: See glossary.
- V. POLICY:
 1. Site healthcare staff follows the specific institution's written plan for responding to allegations of sexual assault of offenders. The plans are consistent with DOC Policy 8.60, Prison Rape Elimination Act, regarding federal reporting regulations under the Prison Rape Elimination Act of 2003.


