- I. **AUTHORITY:** 11 *Del.C.* § 6533, § 6536, § 6539, § 6551, 29 *Del. C.* §8903, § 8905
- II. **PURPOSE:** To authorize the Department to transfer offenders to public or private community-based programs.
- III. **APPLICABILITY:** All Department employees, volunteers, persons or organizations conducting business with the Department; all offenders under the supervision of the Department.
- IV. **DEFINITIONS:**
 - Executive Committee:** The Commissioner and staff designated by the Commissioner.
- V. **POLICY:** It is the policy of the Department of Correction to transfer selected offenders to public or private community-based programs, when appropriate, for rehabilitation purposes, pursuant to court ordered sanctions, or to comply with the SENTAC guidelines.

As authorized by the Delaware Code, qualified offenders can be transferred to community-based programs including, but not limited to, employment, substance abuse treatment and vocational training. Procedures to implement these transfers should be established by the Bureaus of Prisons and Community Corrections, with review by the Commissioner and Executive Committee.

Nothing herein is intended to provide any offender with any right, interest or entitlement to employment or work of any kind while under the supervision of the Department.
