**PURPOSE:**

To enhance the safety of an institution and the health care unit.

**POLICY:**

1. An incident report is completed and filed after any injury.
2. Staff and inmate injuries are reviewed to identify potential problems and make corrective actions. This activity is part of each institutional safety committee that includes health care membership.
3. Health care staff attends annual safety in-service and incidences are tracked and investigated by the site Health Service Administrator.
4. Reports on health related events will be transmitted to the site QI committee. Injuries are reviewed for trends and patterns which may be susceptible to systemic interventions.
